The courtroom is located in a refurbished building which also houses Kilmallock branch library and the local area office for Limerick County Council.

## Refurbishment

By using dark furnishings and filtered light the look and feel of a traditional 19<sup>th</sup> century Irish court room has been preserved. At the same time all the facilities expected in a modern court venue have been provided.



## Accessibility

There is ramped access within a sheltered entrance porch to the courthouse accommodation which is set at one level (apart from the 800mm raised dais for the judge).

## Facilities

Meeting rooms and accommodation for legal practitioners and their clients are accessed from the entrance hall. Secure, independent access is provided from the rear for persons in custody, while the judge's chambers, also independently accessed, have views to an enclosed planted courtyard.

## HOW TO GET THERE

### *By Train (Iarnród Éireann)*

No train service to Kilmallock - nearest train stop is Charleville (9.66km away)

### *By Bus (Bus Éireann)*

Route 329 from Limerick (to Manus, Bruff, Kilmallock, Kilfinane). For timetable details visit [www.buseireann.ie](http://www.buseireann.ie)

### *By Car*

**From Limerick:** Head Southeast on N24.

Continue to follow N24, at Tipperary roundabout take 1st exit onto Kilmallock Road/R512. Continue to follow R512. The courthouse is situated right at Railway Road.

**From Cork:** Take N20 sign post Limerick/Mallow/Blarney. Travel 57.7km. Enter Charleville. Turn right at Chapel Street/R515 (signposted Kilmallock/Tipperary). Continue to follow R515, enter Kilmallock. Turn right at Railway Road.

### **Parking**

There is limited public parking available in front of the courthouse. Disc parking is available in the town.
